ABOUT JACK MORGAN (1950-2026):

Jack Morgan was an Architect, Specifications Writer and past President of the Indianapolis Chapter. Jack was also past President of the CSI Great Lakes Region, and represented Indianapolis and the Great Lakes Region on the CSI National Board of Directors. He was also honored as a Fellow of the Institute in 2018.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP:

The Foundation is now accepting applications for our 2026 Memorial Trust Scholarship. Scholarship award(s) will be determined no later than April 30, 2026.

Applications may be found online at www.csieducationfoundation.org.

Successful recipient(s) will be invited to attend our annual Awards Dinner in June to be recognized. If so, attendance is encouraged but is not required.

Awards are not renewable, but if eligible, an applicant or recipient may reapply in subsequent years.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Completed applications must be received on or before 12:00 Midnight, **Friday, March 6, 2026**.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants must meet all eligibility requirements at the time of application.
2. Applicant must be currently enrolled at a college within the State of Indiana; or, be an Indiana resident currently enrolled in college elsewhere, pursuing a design or construction related degree, e.g., architecture, engineering, interior design, construction administration, etc.
 - a. Determination of degree eligibility is at the sole discretion of the Foundation.
3. Applicant must have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours.
4. Applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on scale of 4.0.

INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION :

1. Determination of scholarship award(s) and notification of successful applicant(s) will be made no later than April 30, 2026. Notification will be via telephone or email.
2. Applicants will not be interviewed.
3. Applications are to be received at ***scholarships@csieducationfoundation.org*** on or before 12:00 Midnight, **Friday, March 6, 2026**.

COMPLETE APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

1. **ESSAY:** an essay of no more than 200 words about your life goals, career expectations and the reasons you would benefit from this scholarship.
2. **TRANSCRIPT:** an overall transcript of college coursework and grades (may be an unofficial copy).
3. **RESUME:** include work experience, community service, honors and awards, amount and year of award of all prior scholarships received, extracurricular activities or achievements, etc.
4. **RECOMMENDATION LETTERS:** Two letters of recommendation, by professors, instructors or employers familiar with you and your qualifications, as follows:
 - a. Letters must be emailed by the Author directly to the Foundation on or before 12:00 Midnight, **Friday, March 6, 2026**
 - b. "Recommendation Letter for <Applicant Name>" must be included in the subject line.
 - c. It is the applicant's obligation to ensure their letters are properly emailed by their respective authors.
 - d. The Foundation is not responsible for unsent or misdirected letters.
 - e. Letters forwarded by the applicant will result in disqualification of the applicant.

CRITERIA FOR AWARDING THE SCHOLARSHIP:

| 2. Essay | 25% |
| 3. Recommendation Letters | 25% |
| 4. GPA | 15% |
| 5. Grades, Honors and Extracurricular Activities | 15% |
| 6. Judge's Discretion | 10% |
